Debra Caplan's one-of-a-kind, glazed ceramic sculptures are petite, sensual pieces inspired by the female figure. The sculptures are finished with a bronze-like glaze and many combine a scored surface texture that highlight the planes of the form creating movement across the surface of the piece.

Debra's sculptures are included in private ceramic collections in Massachusetts, New York, California and Florida.
